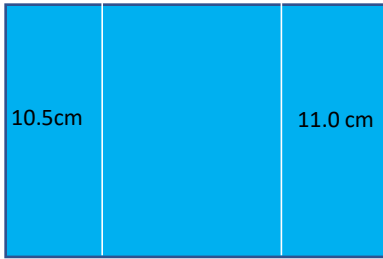
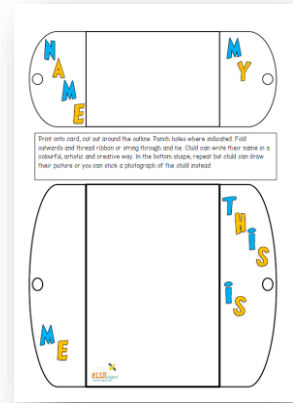


# Making your Personalised Story Lapbook

You will need one A3 sheet of card folded from both sides. Measurements are shown below. You need a slight overlap so you can either stick a bit of Velcro or blu tack to keep it closed when not in use:

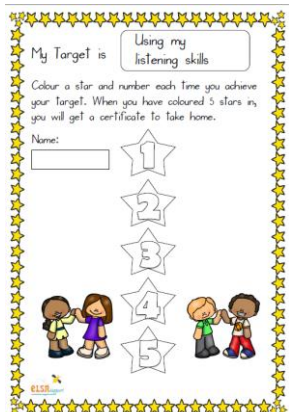
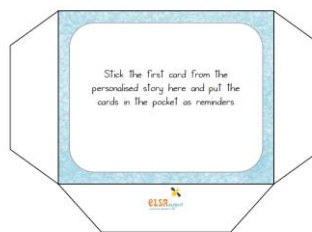


Print out the name and image sheet. There is a black and white version too. Cut around the edges and ask the child to write their name and draw their picture. You could add a photo here too if you prefer. Stick these on one of the front flaps of the lapbook.

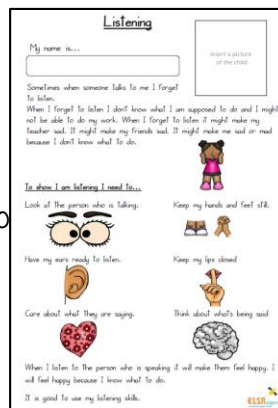


Print out the title cover. There is a girl version, a boy version in colour and in black and white. There is also a plain version. Stick this on the other flap of the lapbook.

Print out the pockets. On the first pocket you need to stick the first card from your personalised story. Stick the pocket to one of the inside flaps of the lapbook. Stick the other pockets on the inside flaps of the lapbook and print out the cards to put inside each one.



Print the target sheet from your story and stick to the back of the lapbook. You might need to trim it slightly on each side.



Print the story and stick that inside the lapbook so the flaps cover it. You might need to trim it slightly on each side.
